A meeting of Bridgwater Without Parish Council was held at Morganians RFC Club on 23 August 2018, Parish Councillors Carver, Hooper, Kennedy, Young, Councillor Alder, Hall, Perry and 3 parishioners.

- 1406. Councillor Kennedy welcomed members and parishioners to the meeting.
- 1407. There were apologies received and accepted from Councillors Davies, Ellicott and Lane.
- 1408. There were declarations received from Councillor Kennedy, 1416 ~tender.
- 1409. Public Speaking ~ Mrs Alway requested support regarding the lack of pedestrian crossing on Bristol Road, report attached.
Councillor Hall agreed to look into this and respond, Clerk to write to highways requesting support.
- 1410. Minutes of the meetings held 19/07/2018 were signed as correct records.
- 1411. Arising from the minutes ~ 1381 the entire £25 is for the pavilion.

Councillor Alder reported that SDC have a Pilot for the movement of shipping in the river. SDC have a healthy budget, internal changes are moving along satisfactorily. Housing continues to be an issue that is being addressed.
Councillor Perry had made enquiries as requested by the Clerk regarding Neighbourhood Planning, she gave information and offered support.
