



# BRIDGWATER WITHOUT PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of Bridgwater Without Parish Council was held at Morganians RFC Club on 22 November 2018, Parish Councillors Carver, Davies, Ellicott, Kennedy, Lane, Young, District Councillor Perry, County Councillor Hall and 2 parishioners.

- 1447. Councillor Davies welcomed members and parishioners to the meeting.
- 1448. There were apologies received and accepted from Councillor Hooper and District Councillor Alder.
- 1449. There were no declarations received.
- 1450. Public Speaking ~ Mrs Hellier asked if there could be a bridge over the rhyne behind the school.  
Mrs Kennedy said that there were issues over cyclists not looking when leaving the cycle path on Bath Road near the roundabout jct with Whitfield Road. Clerk to ask PCSO to check on this.
- 1451. Minutes of the meetings held 20/10/2018 were signed as a correct record.
- 1452. Arising from the minutes ~ Update from Morganians on the grant given, agreed that the £1500 grant was the correct amount. They are applying for RLT3 monies, this grant will be received by the PC before sending on to SDC.
- 1453. Councillor Hall reported the hospital roundabout remains in the hands of the developer and that Highways will keep the grasses at an acceptable height for safety. The crossing on A38 Express Park is due for second half of 2019, funding is in place. Councillor Kennedy nudged Councillor Hall for vehicle charging point's information. Councillor Ellicott asked why salt bins were placed as higher importance than filling pot holes, rationale is that the salt prevents potholes, plus the extra monies have to be spent by the end 2018.  
Councillor Perry reported that the Grants Committee have monies available for individuals up to £500 and £2500 for charities.  
Councillor Kennedy asked if SDC are planning to put electric charging points into public car parks.
- 1454. Councillor Lane reported that a car had entered the ditch on A372.  
Councillor Young requested speed camera checks for Bower Lane as there have been 3 vehicles in the ditch in the last week. Requests for a 30mph on Westonzoyland Road jct at Chedzoy and Dunwear turning due to accidents.  
Councillor Davies reported fly tipping in Dunwear, clerk had reported these.
