



BRIDGWATER WITHOUT PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of Bridgwater Without Parish Council was held at Morganians RFC Club on 27 June 2019, Parish Councillors Davies, Ellicott, Kennedy, Young, County Councillor Hall, District Councillors Perry, Betty and 4 parishioners.

1540. Councillor Kennedy welcomed members to the meeting.
1541. There were apologies received and accepted from Parish Councillor Lane.
1542. There were no declarations of interest in the agenda.
1543. Councillor Vacancy not discussed.
1544. Public speaking Mrs Hellier shared information about a consultation meeting regarding the new building works planned for Willowdown School. The issue of children having difficulty walking to school as pedestrian access to the school is difficult. Councillor Davies walked a route with the CEO from the school. The PC are going to try to assist with a solution regarding this. Councillor Davies has met with Persimmon to discuss a way forward. Suggestions that a bridge was put over the rhyne to allow access directly into the playing field adjacent to the school tennis courts. Councillor Perry has been speaking to planners to try to assist with this issue. Assurance was given at the consultation meeting that KDP wouldn't be affected by the build. Speeding is also an issue Councillor Hall suggested that a speed awareness group be formed to carry out speed checks, Clerk to look into this. Councillor Young was alarmed that there was no help regarding the pedestrians on Kings Down, he is fearful that a child will be injured or at worst killed. Councillor Hall reminded that another pedestrian crossing is planned. Parish Councillor Davies arrived at 7.50pm.
1545. Minutes of the meeting held 21/05/2019 were signed as a correct record.
1546. Arising from minutes
1514 Councillor Davies, to discuss with RK Bell as works completed but not entirely as expected.
1537 Hedge had been cut but requires more attention, Clerk to contact highways.
1501 Councillor Davies reported a grant application for Bridgwater Angling Association, they request funds to purchase fencing and a gate, and they are completing considerable works in this area. Councillor Kennedy felt that as this is a green area in the parish it should be supported. Councillor Davies suggested that the PC purchased the fencing direct. Councillor Kennedy proposed, seconded by Councillor Young, unanimously agreed.
1547. Councillor Hall reminded that Bawdrip have a speed watch group and felt sure that they would loan the kit to facilitate this happening.
He reported that SCC had finished the year with a small surplus of funds, the Health and Wellbeing budget will return again with applications (that must be supported by a quote) from September.
He reported that he is now Chairman of the SRA.
Councillor Hall left the meeting at 8.40pm.
Councillor Perry reported that she was now on the planning committee and would therefore leave the meeting during planning discussions.
Councillor Betty, introduced himself and said that both he and Councillor Perry were on the IDB.
