



BRIDGWATER WITHOUT PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of Bridgwater Without Parish Council was held at Morganians RFC Club on 28 March 2019, Parish Councillors Carver, Davies, Hooper, Kennedy, Lane, Young, County Councillor Hall and 3 parishioners.

1495. Councillor Davies welcomed members and parishioners to the meeting.
1496. There were apologies received and accepted from Councillor Ellicott and District Councillor Perry.
1497. There were no declarations of interest in the agenda.
1498. Public Speaking ~ Mrs Hellier has emailed Highways to request permission to put signs onto the lamp posts on Kings Drive.
1499. Minutes of the meetings held 28/01/2019 were signed as a correct record.
1500. Arising from the minutes ~ 1489 Councillor Lane has looked at the slope Plum Lane, he suggests that a tarmac contractor would need to complete this. Councillor Kennedy proposed Bill Frost, Councillor Young seconded.
1501. Councillor Hall reported that a balanced budget had been presented. The proposed Toucan crossing on Bristol Rd A38 is looking positive once the legal matters regarding cycle paths have been resolved.
Meeting set up with Nigel Gillard from the Angling Association (Dunwear Ponds), Councillor Kennedy to attend.
Councillor Kennedy asked what plans were in place to accommodate building works to avoid impacting on KDP users.
Councillor Davies asked if there were financial issues with Hinkley Point as workers were being laid off, Councillor Hall explained that this was because their work was completed and that as sections complete different skills will be required.
Councillor Young asked if more crossings could be provided to keep pedestrian's safe on Kings Down. Councillor Hall explained that this could be resolved with a small grants improvement scheme application. Councillor Young is very concerned that children are at risk.
A resident asked Councillor Hall if developers liaised with local councils, he said that this would be a great idea that he would support.
Councillor Hall left the meeting at 8.15pm
1502. Councillor Young reported Bower Lane tarmac up to the ditch, no marker posts or kerb, Clerk to contact highways.
Councillor Kennedy reported cars parked on Kings Drive, this is an obvious danger at school times, Clerk to check status of the road.

1504. Clerk reported she had made contact with Stuart Todd regarding supporting the PC to write a Neighbourhood Plan, all agreed to set up a meeting.
