1861	The Chairman welcomed members and parishioners to the meeting.	
1862	Apologies were received and accepted from Parish Councillors, Davies, Ellicott, Councillors Perry and Rodrigues.	
1863	There were no declarations received.	
1864	Parishioners asked for support with noise, dust/light/environmental pollution HGV and LV movements. Businesses in Plum Lane appeared to have no regard to the residents, fears of accidents were shared. Wooden structure in River Lane again discussed, Clerk advised that enforcement support had been sought. Update sought for Strawberry Grange/roundabout. 1865	Minutes of meeting held 18 th August were signed as a correct record.	
1866	1858 – Skipton application form completed, signatories Mr R Kennedy and Mr M Ellicott, 2 to sign, 1855 – community speed watch suggested that as Chedzoy and Westonzoyland are looking into this request joining up. 1856 – IDB have prevented crossing on Kings Drive as they have refused use of their land. Suggested high friction strips and alert signs.	Clerk to take completed form to Skipton BS. Clerk to investigate.
1867	Councillor Dingwall shared new CEO for Somerset Duncan Sharky. There are investments in buses, reduction in costs of bus travel. New Lord Lieutenant is in place. LCN consultation, informal virtual meeting with clerks and chairs arranged for 10/10. RK asked about plans for green charging points, there are at new Northgate Yard.	Clerk to invite Ryan to meeting.
1868	LB asked for trees/hedge for land between Willow man play area and the motorway to add extra screening. She queried why the PC was not member of SALC – consensus that it was not necessary. ME checked that oil container had been removed – Clerk confirmed. RK – suggested that KDP fire exit doors require thought as hirers of the centre are propping them open with broom handles. Also reported that Strawberry Fields (Bower Flowers) piling was bothersome especially as it starts approx. 7.30am. Clerk responded that the site manager has given assurance of start time no earlier than 8am.	Clerk to investigate screening with TrustMGT.

1869	Clerks report KDP – kitchen refurbishment continues, flooring/walls covering quotation shared. Carpets at both exits need replacing – agreed. Containers ordered. Finger post training – requested volunteers. Riverbank footpath towards Black Bridge requires annual cut back. Strawberry Fields – Bower Lane edge of carriageway dangerous with huge potholes, groundwork company (B&A Group) have agreed to repair and maintain as issue caused by HGVs going to and from site. Event Poppies appear to be unavailable – alternative of Tommy lamp post sign, thicker and will hopefully be reusable year on year, agreed to purchase. Creative Car Parks proposal discussed, agreed that it was a necessity as the issue was ongoing added to this was anti-social behaviours later in the evening. Contract length was queried, agreed that decision would be made by email.	Clerk to email out to PCs for decision. Clerk to obtain quotes. Clerk to instruct Jay's Gardening. Clerk to purchase. Clerk to send out proposal, Parish Councillors to view and respond all with thoughts.
