24/07/60	The meeting minutes held on 27 th June 2024 were agreed upon unanimously and signed as correct.
24/07/61	Arising from the minutes not on the agenda: 24/06/54 – The hedge at Kings Drive has been cut by the owner. 24/06/54 – SIDs awaiting approval from the council. 24/06/52 – RD has spoken to the Angling Association regarding the litter/rubbish left near the permanent litter bins at Dunwear and agreed to monitor the situation. 24/06/55 – resolved to instruct Will Stone for a deeper cut as visibility issues continue.
24/07/62	Unitary Councillor reports: None
24/07/63	Reports from Parish Councillors: RK gave a report regarding the LCN. The previous year's focus was heavily weighted towards sustainable travel, and this will continue. PM - reported that he had attended the community event at the pavilion which was aimed at collecting responses to a light survey for the community review. He also spoke about the riverbank at Dunwear as the footpath was becoming impassable due to vegetation growth and resolved that the quote should be accepted and instructed. Clerk to instruct ASAP. There was also a discussion about Squibbers Way, where the footpath is impossible due to brambles and other vegetation. Resolved that the clerk to email highways for assistance with this matter. LB - reported the free event at the pavilion that was also attended by PM and Councillor Rodriguez. Councillor Rodriguez has offered to help with the final survey. There is going to be a free event, bouncy castle, face painting plus with charges a bar and food. There will also be a nature day at the pavilion 17 th August. ME – hedges and brambles along Kings Drive adjacent to the school are causing user issues. Resolved that RD agreed to contact Bloor Homes, RD and ME are to look at solutions for the cutback.
